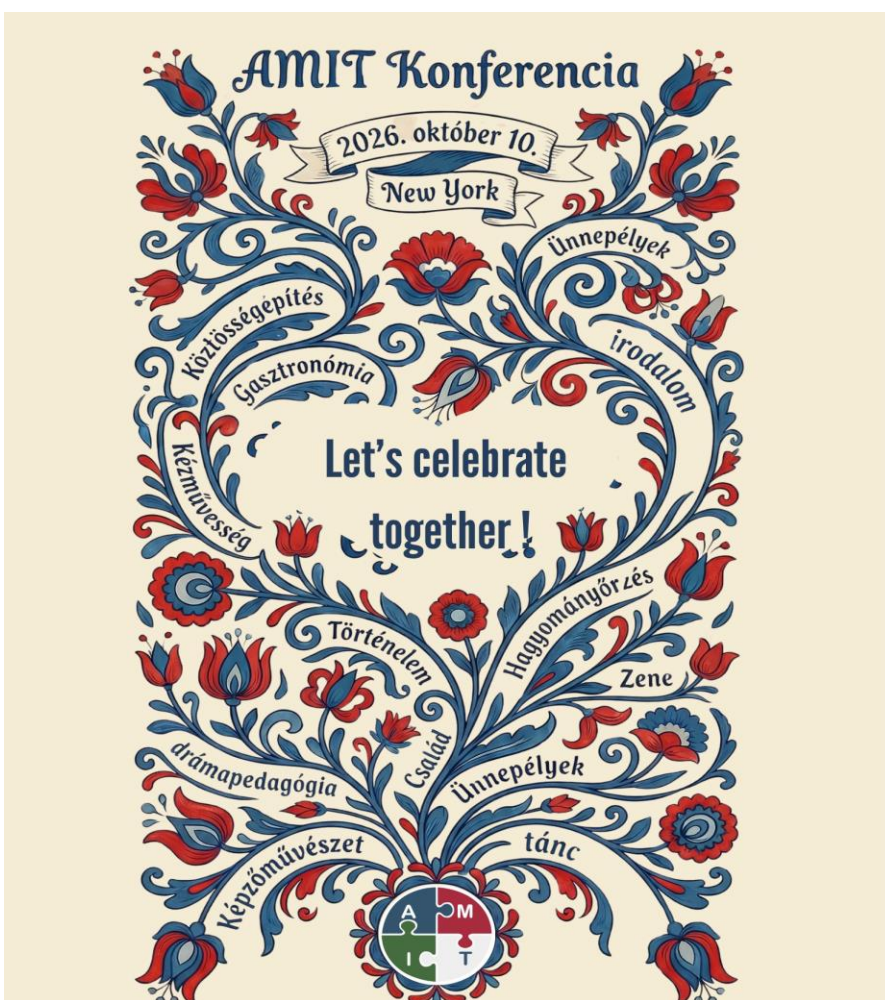

THE NEW BRUNSWICK HUNGARIAN FESTIVAL



On June 6, 2026, New Brunswick will once again come alive as a vibrant hub of Hungarian culture when one of the largest Hungarian street festivals in the United States returns. Traditionally held on the first Saturday of June, the event is expected to draw thousands of visitors to Somerset Street, which transforms into a true “Little Hungary” for the day.

The festival welcomes guests from 11:00 AM to 6:00 PM and is organized by the American Hungarian Foundation. Its mission is to showcase the richness and diversity of Hungarian culture: visitors can enjoy all-day folk music and folk-dance performances, traditional foods—including lángos and sausage—artisan vendors, children’s activities, and a variety of cultural showcases.

AMIT representatives will also be present at the festival, where they will showcase the organization's activities. Visitors can learn more about AMIT's work and mission at their stand.

The event is free of charge and open to all ages.

THE FIRE OF OUR UNITY



The Fire of Our Unity initiative was launched on the 100th anniversary of the Treaty of Trianon, based on the idea of the Transcarpathian Hungarian Scout Association. Since then, it has grown into a worldwide, tradition-building movement. The program aims to connect Hungarians across the globe by commemorating the tragedy of Trianon, Saint Stephen's thousand-year Christian statehood, and the legal unity made possible through dual citizenship. Its roots reach back to historic scout fire-lighting traditions, and this year, due to the ongoing war in Ukraine, the flames will also serve as "Fires of Peace," offering participants a moment to pray together for the swift end of the armed conflict.

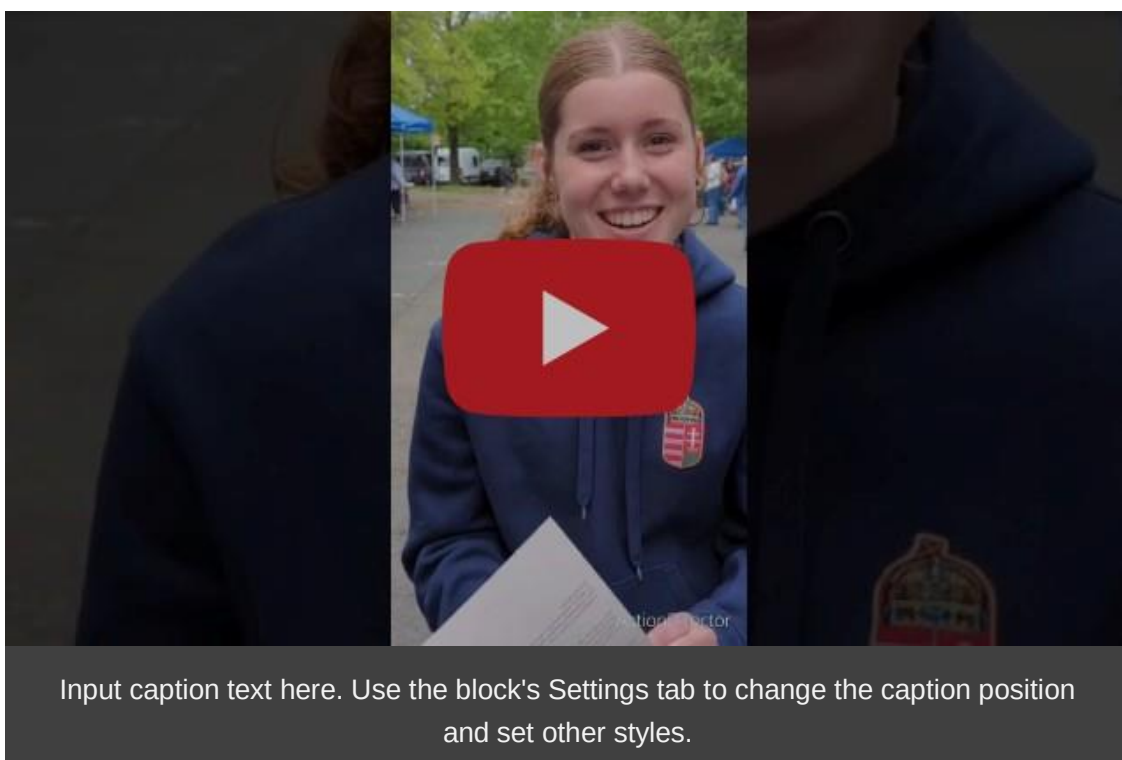
Anyone—individuals, families, or organizations—may join the program by completing a short registration on the official website and indicating the location of their fire, while strictly observing all local safety and fire regulations. The global commemoration culminates on **June 4**, when, at exactly **20:26 Budapest time**, **fires will be lit simultaneously in every corner of the world** where Hungarians live.

This year, the organizers are adding a new virtual element to strengthen the sense of togetherness: participants are encouraged to connect their fire-lighting with communities in other countries through live video links, fostering direct interaction, new friendships, and cross-border connections.

HUNGARIAN WORLD SCHOOL – INTERVIEW AT THE ECL CERTIFICATE HANDOVER IN WASHINGTON, DC



The Hungarian Heritage Festival brought an unexpected highlight for three young participants from the Washington area. Zoltán C. (16), Dávid K. (14), and Hanna K (17) found themselves at the center of a language certificate handover.

These students successfully completed the B2-level ECL Hungarian as a Foreign Language Exam through the *Hungarian World School* program. Although their certificates were originally meant to be handed over during a brief, informal meeting, the circumstances naturally created the opportunity for a spontaneous, yet memorable moment.

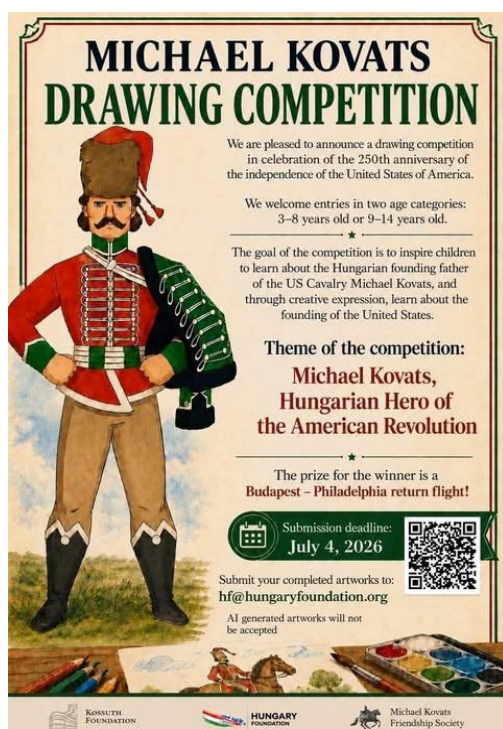

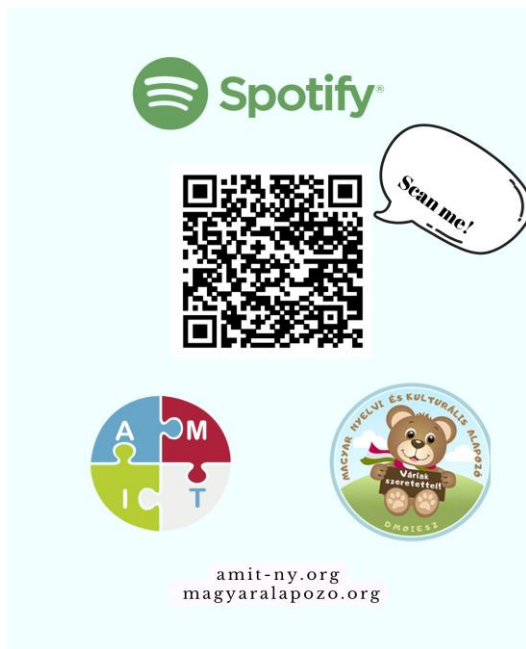


Warning, things are heating up – summer is on its way!
