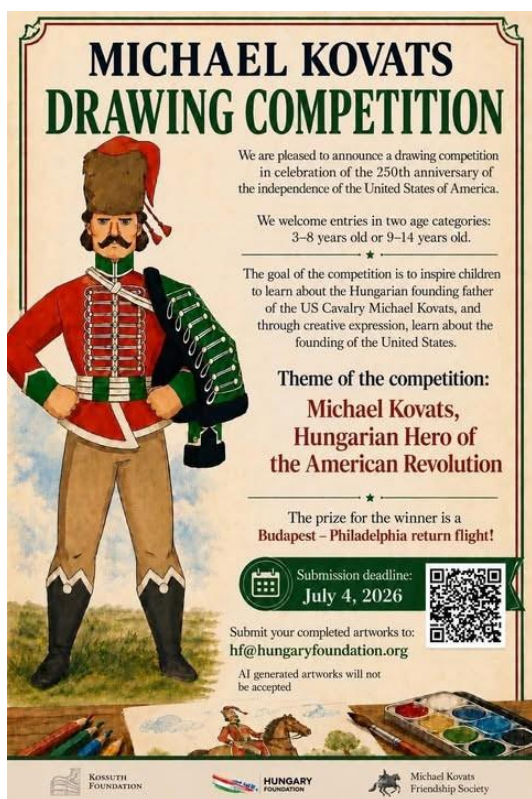

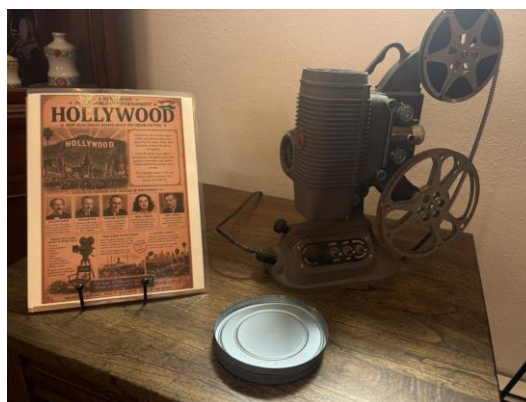
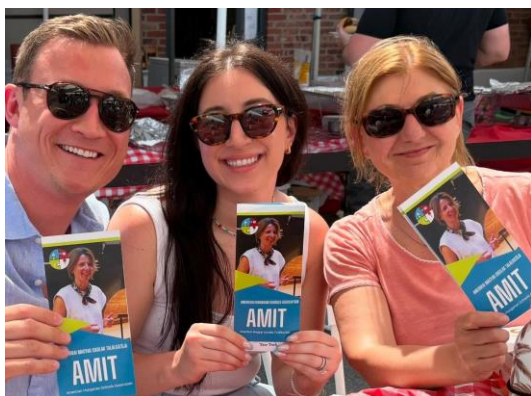
- Entries are accepted in two age categories: 3–8 years and 9–14 years

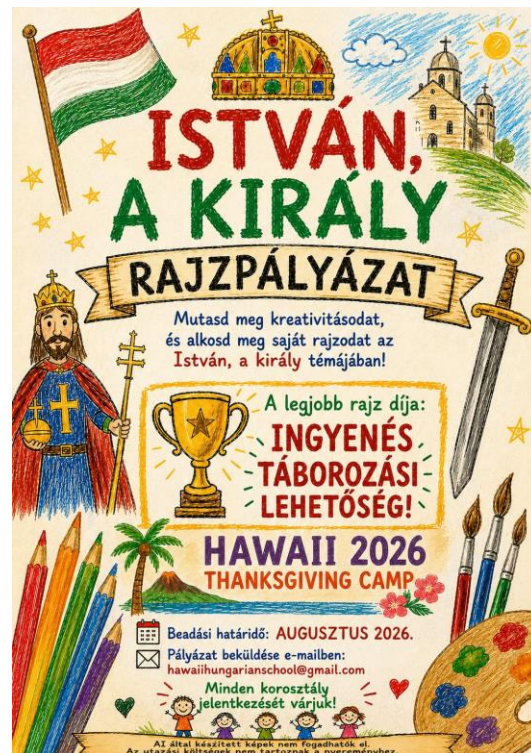

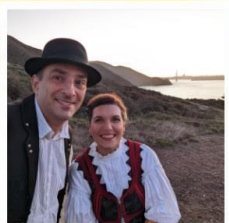

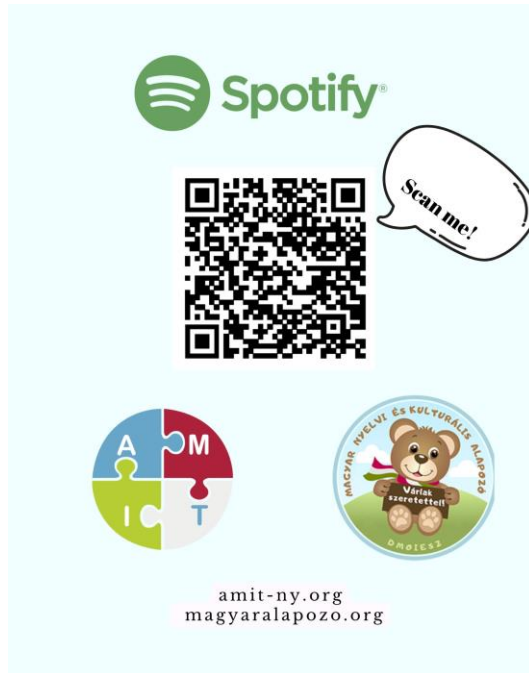
