Furthermore, they have the opportunity to build a community with other scholarship holders and facilitators.

The applicant who devotes time and energy to the development of his own and his colleagues' teaching methods will receive a \$100 scholarship. He actively participates throughout the academic year and receives a financial allowance in recognition of his commitment.
